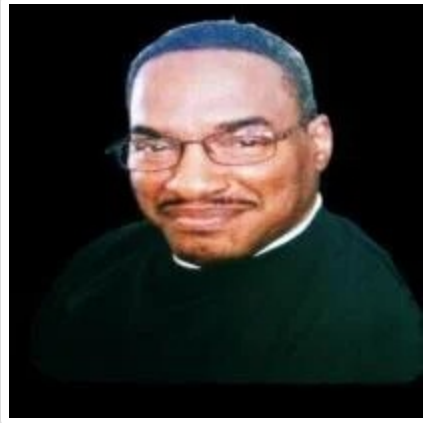




Mr. Jerome Anthony Bonten
