Life Reflections of Elder Misonn Emon Wallace

Misonn was born on April 11, 1973, in Indianapolis, Indiana to the late Jacqueline White and the late Herman Wallace Sr. . On July 11, 2015, he married Exceletria Wallace and they shared six children.

As we all know Misonn has always had his foot in a church door. Misonn started off at Bethel Tabernacle Pentecostal Apostolic in Indianapolis, Indiana as child. Years later Misonn and his family moved to Houston, Texas and found a new church home. He was saved and baptized at a young age at Emmanuel Deliverance Temple of Refuge (under the leadership of Bishop Bobby D. Butler, Sr.) in Houston, Texas. He became a witness wherever he went, known for preaching and singing during street meetings. He was later ordained a minister and an elder. Misonn subsequently joined Greater Emmanuel Family Worship Center under the leadership of Pastor Titus B. Stewart. Misonn served as an elder and a song leader, and remained a dedicated member. The Lord called him home on the morning of Thursday, June 7, 2018.

Misonn attended Johnson Elementary School, Hambrick Middle School and Mac Arthur High School, all resided in Houston, Texas. He was a star football player at Mac Arthur and was affectionately called “The Refrigerator”. He also studied The Adjutancy at Joint College of Bishops. Misonn was also an entrepreneur. He started his trucking business over ten years ago and employed many people who loved him dearly.

Misonn loved life, his family, and his friends, but only God knew how much he loved Football. With all of his passion and heart left on the field, Douglas MacArthur High School inducted him into their Hall of Fame. Misonn was All District in 1990. As the founder of Misonn Freight Services LLC, Misonn provided opportunities for men in such impoverished economic conditions. Misonn’s presence will be missed by his employees.
